


AIAA Continuing Education

Access Instructions for On-Demand Courses

1. Go to <https://aiaa.mycrowdwisdom.com/diweb/mylearning>
2. Click on the [Sign In](#) button in the top right corner.
3. **Login** with your AIAA.org account.
If you do not have one, you may create an AIAA.org account for free.
4. Click on the tab, **My Learning**.
5. Click on the button, **View Details**, beneath the course title within the tab, **Enrolled**. You will be redirected to the Course Page.
