What is an AIAA Regional Student Conference?

- An opportunity for students to write a paper, present it, and publish it in a smaller conference setting with a chance to win cash prizes.
- AIAA hosts 7 student conferences each year.
 - Regions I-VI occur annually in March/April, while Region VII is every November.
- Conferences also offer an experience for students to hear from guest speakers, network with other students and professionals, see lab/facility/corporate tours, engage in recruitment opportunities, etc.
- Anyone is welcome to attend the student conference, but there are specifications to presenting at one.

Eligibility to Present at a Student Conference

- Must be an AIAA Student Member to present a paper
- Undergraduate and Graduate students
 - Early doctoral candidates with coursework also eligible.
- Offers 3 Paper Categories: Undergraduate (2 student authors), Graduate (2 student authors), and Undergraduate Team (3 student authors or more).
 - Only Region VI & VII currently accepting high school papers.
- Schools can participate in another region's conference (By request).

What To Prepare

- ✓ Join/renew your AIAA Student Membership.
- ✓ Submit an abstract 1-2 paragraphs (1,000 words max) by the deadline.
- ✓ Submit an up to [11-page manuscript](#) by the final paper deadline.
 - ✓ Complete a copyright form if you'd like AIAA to publish your paper.
- ✓ Register for the conference.
- ✓ Prepare your presentation.
 - ✓ [PPT slide deck](#)
- ✓ Attend the conference and present.
 - ✓ 30-minute presentation time slot: 20 minutes to present with up to 10 minutes for judge and audience questions.

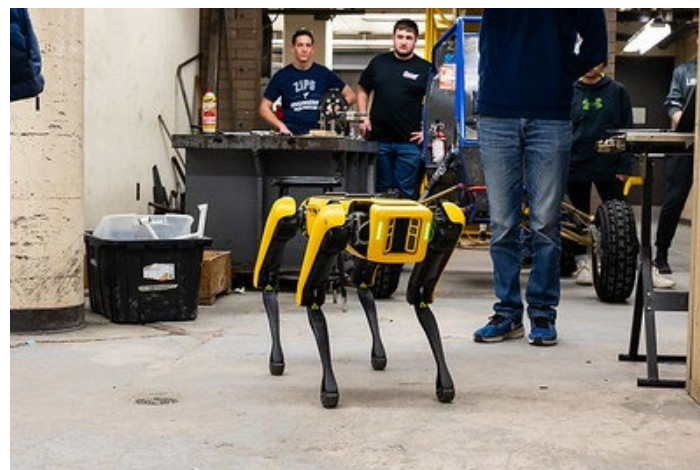

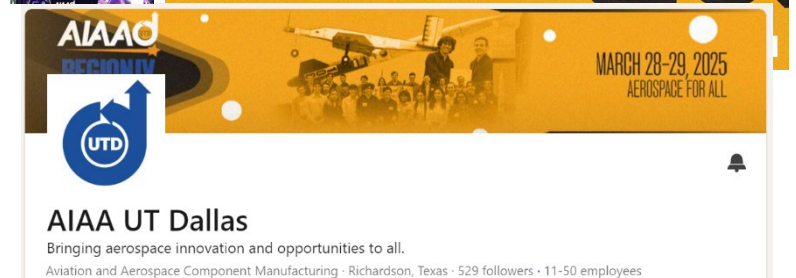
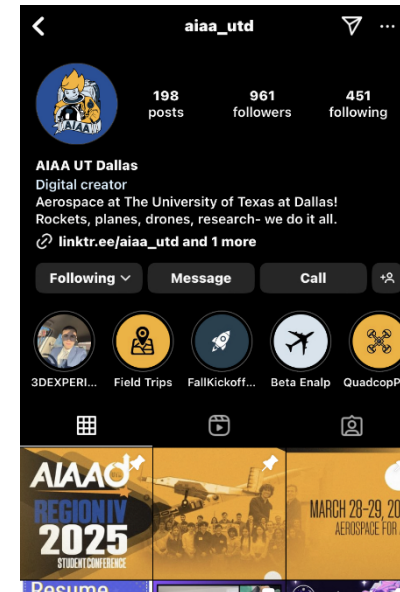
2025 Conference Dates, Locations & Abstract Deadlines
